Grave in Ashville Cemetery, town of Harmony. He served in Col. Philip Bradley's Battalion, Wadsworth Brigade, also in Capt. Reuben Scofield's Company, Connecticut Militia. He is mentioned as a pensioner in the census of 1840, aged 87, residing with William Dean in the town of Harmony. His wife, Sarah, died March 17, 1845, aged 90 years, and is buried beside him.
