1. Typed on 8½ x 11 sheet of paper, double spaced.
2. Only one query may be made on a page.

4. Give name of person, date and place of birth, marriage and death dates (if possible) and any other pertinent information.
5. Do not ask to exchange information on lists of surnames.
6. If space is limited, only one query per person will be published.
7. When writing to members asking for information, please ALWAYS enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope, no loose stamps nor money should be sent.

HARKINS FAMILY GRAVEYARD

About four miles north of Calera, Alabama, on Highway 31 is a little community called DARGAN. West of this place about one mile, on the right of the road is an old graveyard.

The following notations were copied from stones in this cemetery.

ANDREW HARKINS - born May 22, 1780 - died Jan. 16, 1851.

ELIZABETH HARKINS - born Dec. 25, 1782 - died Feb. 5, 1836.

HUGH HARKINS - born July 26, 1804 - died Sept. 27, 1835.

WILLIAM HARKINS - born May 19, 1807 - died July 1, 1870.

SARAH WILSON - born March 9, 1812 - died Oct. 9, 1852. (Wife of Thomas F. Wilson)

This land was owned first by Harkins and second by Wilsons. It is now owned by the family of Mr. Pierce Youngblood, who bought it in 1901.
