In Old Union Street Cemetery

This list, will add some, correct some and clear up some of the doubtful entries, listed in the printed vital records.

The old stones are of red sandstone, some badly weathered and rather difficult to decipher. The differences in the vital records have been carefully compared with the stones.

B , F..... a footstone, reading, F. B. 1731

Bagg, Noah, Sept. 31, (not 30) 1746.

Ball, Mrs. Sarah, a footstone, (not in V.R. as in G.R. 1.


Barber, Mrs. Sarah, Relict of John, died Aug. 5, 1733, in the 39 yr. (not 82).

Barber, Thomas, s. Thomas & Sarah, died, Dec. 14, 1713, in 4 y. (not in V.R.).

Cook, Sarah, dau. Ebenezer & Sarah, died 1733, in 12 y.

(not 2).

Cooley, Lt. Abel, s. of Capt. Abel & Marcy, died at Valley
Forge in the service of his Country June 13, 1778
in 32 y. (not in V.R.).





- Jones, Sarah, w. of Peletiah (not Pelatiah) on her stone.
- Leonard, Cyntha (on gravestone), d. Sept. 26, 1776, in 4th. y.

 Tamar, d. Sept. (looks more like 10 than 19) 1776, a. 3 y.

 Mary, d. Aug. 2, 1777, in 11 m. (all these three on one stone).
- Leonard, Nathaniel, d. July 6, 1734, in 49 y. (not in VR.).
- Miller, S. M. D. M.

 also Anne Miller, d. Aug. 27. 1773, a. 7 m.

 (these three on one stone) (probably S. M. is for Solomon Miller, and D. M. is for Desire Miller)
- Miller,HER, died May 20 1757 im her 18 y.


