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

PREFACE.

Some years since, or in 1895, it became evident to the compiler that many of the gravestone inscriptions in our two ancient cemeteries were fast becoming difficult to decipher because of the slow but sure disintegration of the eldest monuments, for which reason he undertook the difficult task of copying them while it was possible to do so. The labor has been performed con amore, and the town at its annual meeting in 1901 kindly voted to place the matter of publishing the compilation in the hands of the Cemetery Commissioners, and this pamphlet is the result, which the compiler trusts will be of use to posterity as well as acceptable to his fellow townsmen.

It may be noted in passing that the compiler has added largely to the list of burials where no headstones appear, when names and dates could possibly be ascertained from the records or relatives. But owing to the indefinite manner in which the returns were rendered, till recently, it has been very difficult and often impossible to tell from the records in which of our six cemeteries burials have been made, when monuments are not in evidence. For which reason there will ever remain many nameless graves in our two oldest cemeteries. This lack of information may be remedied in some measure if anyone to whose notice this list may come, who has knowledge of any full account of burial which does not appear in the published list, will give the same to the compiler.

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History of the Palmer Cemetery.

1729--1901.

"With thy rude ploughshare, Death turn up the sod, And spread the furrow for the seed we sow; This is the field and acre of our God, This is the place where human harvests grow."

One of the sad necessities connected with the settling of every town is the early setting apart of the sacred acre, where, sooner or later, the great majority must find rest after the work of life is done. And so it happened here, for on the 26th of April, 1729, death claimed Moses, the son of the pioneer John King, who first consecrated the ground set apart by the free consent of those who settled early in the precincts of our village, as we find no account of any action on the part of the town connected with it. No stone marks the place of the first burial, nor of many others who soon followed. The oldest headstone in the cemetery bears this inscription: "Here lies the body of Jerusha, daughter of Capt. Nathaniel Vose of Milton, and wife of Andrew Mackee, who died May 22, 1732, 30 years of age."

The first mention in our town records regarding the "South Burying Yard" was on Oct. 8, 1788, when it was voted "That Timothy Brainerd make a "spaid" for the Burying Yard at the row and that he shall have his Pay out of the first town Rate that is assessed." At the same meeting it was voted that "Aaron Merrick, Lt. John King and Dr. Calvin Scott be a committee to fence the South Burying Yard." The committee reported May 8, 1789, that the people of that neighborhood had agreed to erect a fence by subscription, which report was accepted. In 1800 Capt. John King contracted to dig graves at the rate of 25



cents each in the South Yard. The Palmer cemetery was enlarged in 1865 by the addition of three acres of land purchased of Elisha Converse for about \$900, and another addition of about one and one-half acres was made on the east side. After fencing the yard in 1788 the people seemed to have thought their duty had been performed and left it in Nature's care, for when I first saw the grounds a more sadly neglected spot could scarcely be conceived.

Recognizing the need of improvement, a meeting of citizens was called in 1866 to see if something could be done to redeem the cemetery from the forest aspect which it had assumed. In response to this call the Palmer Cemetery Association was formed, a code of by-laws adopted, and these officers elected June 25 of that year: John Ward, president; A. V. Blanchard. vice-president; P. P. Kellogg, secretary and treasurer; and an executive committee consisting of S. R. Lawrence, William Merriam, E. B. Lyon, C. C. Shaw and David Knox. There were seventy-seven members enrolled who paid one dollar each as annual dues, besides eight honorary members who paid five dollars each. The sum of \$100 was raised the first year and \$128 the second. This society existed till 1869, when it was discontinued, but during those four years it wrought a wonderful change. From the record before me I find that 18 cords of wood were cut and sold off the grounds, so it can well be imagined how densely the trees occupied the enclosure. The wood was sold for about \$68.

After this uprising the cemetery was again allowed to take care of itself till June 18, 1888, when the second cemetery association was organized and has been efficiently maintained till the present. It is supported by annual dues from members and by donations. This association deserves well of our people, for it has brought order out of chaos and made attractive and beautiful the grounds which were once an unsightly feature in our village. In 1897 the town voted to purchase about six and one-half acres of land of John M. Converse adjoining the old cemetery on the north at a cost of \$3,000. In the following year the town elected these cemetery commissioners: H. E. W. Clark, for

three years: H. C. Strong, for two years; H. G. Loomis, for one year. In 1899 the commissioners procured plans for the laying out of the added grounds and commenced work thereon, which promises in time to make a very attractive extension to our cemetery.

The inscriptions in the following list cover a period from 1729 to 1895, with such additions as have since come to hand, so that it is quite possible that a few monuments which have been erected since 1895 may have been overlooked, as it has been impossible for me to go over the entire ground again. In many instances known names and dates have been included where no headstones appear, in order to make the list as complete as possible. The monuments include a great variety of material and style, from the undressed field stone of the early days to the massive and polished Scotch granite shaft of to-day. It is notable that during the last decade a large number of costly and elegant monuments have been erected which add much to the character of the cemetery.

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History of the Cemetery at the Old Center of Palmer.

"I like that ancient Saxon phrase which calls
The burial ground God's acre! It is just;
It consecrates each grave within its walls,
And breathes a benison o'er the sleeping dust."

As soon as the matter of locating the meeting house had been decided, steps were taken by the town to locate a burying ground nearby, although the earliest settlers had already set apart a lot for burial purposes in the south part of the district near King's Row. We find on the town records that at a town meeting held March 17, 1734-35, it was voted "That Steward Southgate, Barnard McNitt and Isaac Magoon, Jr., be a committee to pitch upon and lay out a piece of land for a Burying place." Then the records go on to say, "The Burying place layed out May the 12th, 1735, began at an oak bush with a great stone rolled against it, standing about ten rods east of the meeting house, being the norwest corner of the Burying place; thence S. 36 deg., E. 12 rods, to stones on the side hill; thence E. 36 deg., N. 13 rods to a stone against the little Pond in the southeast corner; thence N. 36 deg., W. 12 rods to a stone against a little Hollow in the noreast corner, thence to where we began 13 rods." In 1788 the town added 62 1-2 rods of land to the above lot by exchange with Landlord John Thompson. Soon after the land thus set apart was enclosed by a fence and contains about ten acres. In 1800 Solomon Shaw made a contract to open graves as required for twenty-five cents each. Nothing has ever been done to beautify these grounds or make

them attractive; the very most that has been attempted has been an occasional removal of the brush which persists in putting in an annual appearance.

There are a large number of unnamed graves of the early settlers which cannot now be identified, but doubtless the first burial in the new cemetery was that of Lieut. Samuel Doolittle, although the place of his sepulchre is not known, as no headstone marks his grave. The account of his funeral is thus given in the early records: "Lieut. Samuel Doolittle Departed this Life on Saturday, ye 17th day of July, 1763, After a Short Illness of two or three Days, and was Decently Interr'd on the day following after ve afternoon service, it being the Sacrement Day. A Multitude of people Respectfully attending ve funeral." The first named grave is that of Martha, daughter of Benjamin Parsons, who died Mar. 30, 1737. The earliest headstones were formed from field stones but slightly dressed. These and the red sandstones were used till about 1800, when for a few years a soft flaky gray stone was used which soon proved unfitted for cemetery purposes, as many of them have crumbled into fragments. About 1810 slate was used and has proved a good substitute for sandstone, as it has resisted the elements remarkably well. Then came marble, which still obtains. All the monuments are of the simplest style, fully in keeping with their environments. In May, 1895, the writer spent two days in copying the inscriptions, and the following list is the result, which embraces every epitaph in the vard to that date, save the poetry, which has been left out as non-essential. 
