


There is a map of the Town of Pavilion on the next page.

On the following pages the name or names of the cemetery are listed with the number corresponding to the location on the map.



Bailey's Mills Cemetery

On the Covell Road off Leroy-Bethany Road, northern part of the

Town of Pavilion near Roanoke Abandoned - see: Cooley's, p-139 First burial: 1819 - Last: 1935

Bushnell Family Plot

On the Hawks Road - farm lot at the corner of dirt road parallel to railroad track east of E. Bethany in N.W. corner of Pavilion

Abandoned - see: Cooley's, p-139

First burial: 1835 - Last 1859

Dodson Farm Burial

Located on the Old Pavilion-LeRoy Road - now the Pavilion Center Road - Dodson Farm now owned by David Walton, David says the graves have been moved to Fairview Cemetery

Abandoned - nothing more known

#5

Maplewood Cemetery

Union Corners, South Street Road about one mile south of Rt. 20 west side of road

First burial: c. 1812

GCHD

"Here under the sod and these trees Lieth the body of Ichabod Pease."

Mills Family Plot

South side of Black Street Road, southwest of Mildred Wiedrich's home. No stones but infant burials

#4

Oatka Valley Cemetery (Pavilion Cemetery)

Founded in 1828, located west of Junction 19 and 63 (Big Tree Road or Ellicott Street Road)

Incorporated active cemetery

First burial: 1812

Pavilion Center Cemetery (Fairview or Grandview)

Pavilion Center Road, north of Rt. 20, parallel to Rt. 19, west side of B & O railroad track

Incorporated active cemetery

First burial: 1812

St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery

South of Pavilion four corners on Rt. 19 on east side on a hillside Religious active cemetery

First burial: 1883
