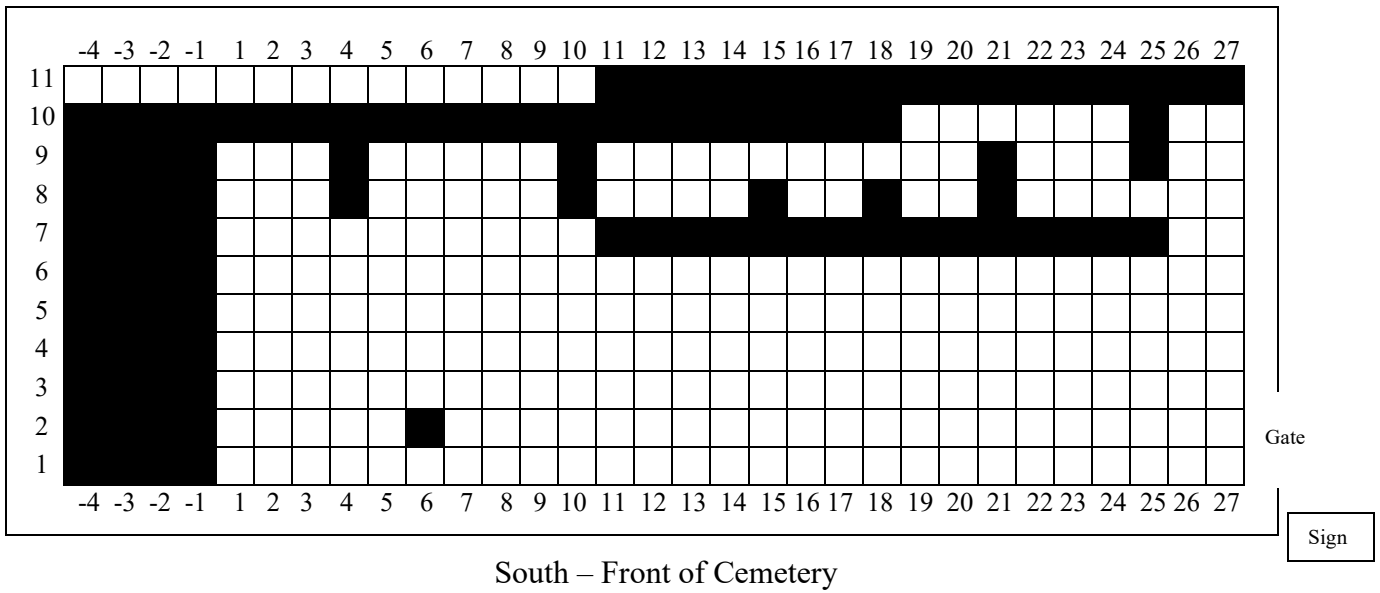


US Disciplinary Barracks Cemetery Layout
